Notes

- 1. We are budgeting for a 2% increase in general giving in 2024.
- 2. Rental income is expected to decease due to the decision of a recurring renter to move to an alternate location.
- 3. Planned expenditures by our program committees is expected to decline by about \$5,000. Cost reductions come from changes in the way programs are delivered (e.g., the way confirmation programming is scheduled eliminates the need for hospitality expenses; use of online as opposed to print-based education materials), lesser needs for some initiatives (e.g., fewer first-time attendees at the Synod Thanksgiving retreat) and general scaling back of planned activities (e.g., Social Ministry).
- 4. Synodical / National Events. The decrease in planned expenditures is largely due to 2024 being a non-CLAY year. Historically, St. Mark's has budgeted \$5,000 every other year to support youth attending the Canadian Lutheran Anglican Youth gathering (CLAY).
 - The Synod Convention fee is based on the baptized membership of the congregation. The fee covers the cost of St. Mark's delegates attending biennial synod conventions and the cost of sending MNO delegates to the triennial National Church.
- 5. Overall administration costs are expected to be flat. As the volume of work processed in the office using paper declines, costs will go down. Bank fees though will increase as the service plan fee on our chequing account will no longer be waived due to the decline in our chequing account balance.
- 6. We have budgeted for a 5% increase in natural gas and electricity costs and a 3% increase in water bills. Arguably, these may be conservative assumptions given what have been heard in the news lately. If actual expenses come in under budget, savings could be used to augment spending in other areas such as Mission Partner Support (see Note 10 below).
- 7. We are bracing for a significant increase in our insurance premium given that a major claim made this year. We are budgeting for a 25% increase. Our insurance broker will be approached early in 2024 to inquire about obtaining additional quotes for coverage.
- 8. We anticipate personnel costs to be about \$20,000 less in 2024 compared to this year.

 The reduction is the result of:
 - a) eliminating the office assistant position.
 - b) cutting back the office administrative position from 24 hours per week to 12-15 hours per week.

- c) removal of the office administrative position from the church wide benefit program, a savings of close to \$5,000. Given the number of budgeted hours, this position would not reach the threshold needed for eligibility.
- d) reduction of the budgeted hours for custodial service to match actual work hours more closely.

The proposed budget maintains funding for the Children's Ministry Coordinator.

Salary increases of 3% are applied to support staff positions. Salary increases planned for professional staff (pastor and music director) take into account guidelines provided by the MNO Synod and the Royal Canadian College of Organists.

- 9. Other HR costs are projected to decrease by about 50%. The largest reduction is related to the generous offer of a volunteer to continue as our bookkeeper.
- 10. The budget for Mission Partner Support is being reduced by almost 50%. The goal for benevolence support to the MNO Synod is set at \$21,000 which is about 8% of what we will spend on programming, administration, property and personnel.
 - The planned goal for a disbursement to Lutheran Urban Ministry is \$1,000, down from \$1,700.
- 11. The budget being presented is essentially a balanced budget showing a very modest net operating income of \$152.
